4. To provide understanding of contemporary tensions in SDA theology in the light of their historic roots.
5. To provide understanding of the hermeneutics underlying SDA theology.
6. To indicate the relevance of SDA theology for the denomination's mission.

Course Objectives:

1. Define and defend the meaning and practice of inspired expository preaching.
2. To sharpen the expository, exegetical and interpretive skills of students.
3. To help students grasp the literary and theological "distinctiveness" of expository preaching and how they can employ it into sermon design and delivery of 1st and 2nd Corinthians.
4. Evaluate and describe the basic hermeneutical and homiletical principles and procedures in the expository sermon preparation.
5. To provide students with additional practice and feedback in the designing, proclaiming and evaluating of expository sermons from 1st and 2nd Corinthians.

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
